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व्याकरण व शब्दसंपदा यांमुळे भाषा समृद्ध बनते. व्याकरणाचा व या शब्दसंपदेचा जेवढा अभ्यास तेवढे भाषेवर प्रभुत्व असे म्हणणे वावगे ठरणार नाही. व्याकरण तसा वरवर अवधड वाटणारा भाग असला तरीही त्याचे योग्य स्पष्टीकरणाद्वारे आकलन झाल्यास व त्याचा योग्य सराव केल्यास तो सहज सोपा होऊ शकतो. या सगळ्यांचा विचार करून इंग्रजी भाषेचे व्याकरण सुलभ करून देण्यासाठी खास तयार करण्यात आलेले महाराष्ट्र राज्य पाठ्यपुस्तक निर्मिती व अभ्यासक्रम संशोधन मंडळाच्या अद्ययावत पाठ्यपुस्तकावर आधारित लेझी बोन एज्युकेशनचे 'English (LL) Grammar (Language Study) & Vocabulary: Std. IX' हे पुस्तक विद्यार्थ्यांच्या हाती सोपवताना आम्हांला अतिशय आनंद होत आहे.

विद्यार्थ्यांची Grammar आणि Vocabulary यांवर आधारित घटकांचे आकलन करून घेण्याची क्षमता वाढवण्यासाठी अत्यंत बारकाईने विश्लेषण करून संक्षिप्त रूपात साकारलेले हे पुस्तक विद्यार्थ्यांची Grammar आणि Vocabulary वर आधारित घटकांचे आकलन करून घेण्याची क्षमता वाढवण्यासाठी आणि परीक्षेत गुणवृद्धीसाठी निश्चितच साहाय्यभूत ठरेल. उत्तम अध्ययन निष्मत्तीकरिता सदर पुस्तकाची रचना विद्यार्थीस्नेही करण्यात आली आहे.

प्रत्येक पाठात Grammar च्या संकल्पनांचे (इंग्रजी आणि/ किंवा मराठीमध्ये) सोप्या भाषेत स्पष्टीकरण दिले आहे. घटकांच्या आवश्यकतेनुसार पाठातील स्वाध्याय तीन विभागांमध्ये विभागला आहे. Textual exercise या विभागात घटकांशी संबंधित पाठ्यपुस्तकातील प्रश्न समाविष्ट करण्यात आले आहेत. पाठ्यपुस्तकातील पाठांवर आधारित प्रश्न Textbook based exercise मध्ये अंतर्भूत करण्यात आले आहेत; तर या घटकांच्या अधिकच्या सरावाकरिता Additional exercise या विभागाचा समावेश करण्यात आला आहे.

त्याचप्रमाणे विद्यार्थ्यांच्या सरावासाठी Grammar Worksheet चादेखील समावेश करण्यात आला आहे. या पुस्तकात समाविष्ट केलेल्या सर्व Exercise व Grammar Worksheet मधील प्रश्नांच्या उत्तर पडताळणीसाठी पुस्तकाच्या शेवटी Answer Key देण्यात आली आहे. विद्यार्थ्यांच्या उत्तम आकलनाकरिता 'Caution' आणि 'Things to Remember' अशी नावीन्यपूर्ण वैशिष्ट्ये यात समाविष्ट करण्यात आली आहेत. यांद्वारे विद्यार्थ्यांना विविध क्लुप्या आणि मोलाचे मार्गदर्शन मिळेल.

'English (LL) Grammar (Language Study) & Vocabulary: Std. IX' हे पुस्तक विद्यार्थ्यांना परीक्षेच्या दृष्टीने उपयुक्त आहेच; परंतु या पुस्तकामुळे विद्यार्थ्यांचा Grammar व Vocabulary घटकांचा अभ्यासही पक्का होईल, अशी आमची खात्री आहे. हे पुस्तक विद्यार्थ्यांची प्रश्न सोडविण्याची क्षमता सुधारण्यासाठी Grammar चा अचूक वापर, वाक्यनिर्मिती आणि लेखन यासंदर्भात मार्गदर्शन देईल हे निश्चित.

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
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# Grammar (Language Study) & Vocabulary

# **Determiners**

A determiner is a word or a group of words that specifies, identifies or quantifies a noun or a noun phrase.

### **Types of Determiners**



### 1. Articles

The articles 'a', 'an' and 'the' are classified as **determiners** because they **specify** nouns. They let the reader/listener know whether a noun has been mentioned previously. 'The' = noun mentioned earlier; 'a' and 'an' = noun not mentioned earlier. There are specific instances where only 'the', 'a' or 'an' can be used.

('a', 'an' आणि 'the' या articles ना determiners मध्ये वर्गीकृत केले जाते; कारण ती Nouns दर्शवतात. याआधी Noun चा उल्लेख झाला आहे, की नाही हे Articles मुळे वाचकांना / श्रोत्यांना समजते. 'The' = Nouns चा उल्लेख पूर्वी झाला आहे. 'a' आणि 'an' = Nouns चा उल्लेख यापूर्वी झालेला नाही. याव्यतिरिक्त, काही विशिष्ट ठिकाणी फक्त 'the', 'a' किंवा 'an' ही articles वापरली जातात.)

### 2. Demonstratives

The words 'this', 'that', 'these' and 'those' are known as demonstratives. Demonstrative determiners are followed by nouns.

**e.g.** ♦ This house is mine.

### ! CAUTION

When words 'this,' 'that,' 'these,' and 'those' are used with nouns like 'this house' or 'those books,'they are acting as demonstrative determiners. However, when they stand alone and replace nouns, as in 'This is my house' or 'I like those,' they become demonstrative pronouns.

(**सूचना:** जेव्हा 'this,' 'that,' 'these,' आणि 'those' हे 'this house' किंवा 'those books' यांसारख्या नामांसोबत वापरले जाते तेव्हा, ते demonstrative determiners म्हणून कार्य करतात; मात्र जेव्हा ते <u>'This</u> is my house' किंवा 'I like <u>those'</u>, अशा प्रकारे स्वतंत्रपणे येतात आणि नामांची जागा घेतात, तेव्हा ते demonstrative pronouns म्हणवले जातात.

### 3. Possessives

The words 'my', 'your', 'his', 'her', 'its', 'our', 'your' and 'their' are known as possessives...

**e.g.** ♦ Is this your coat?

### **CAUTION**

Students should know the difference between Possessive Determiners and Possessive Pronouns. Possessive Determiners are used before nouns to indicate ownership.

**E.g.** This is my car. (Possessive Determiner)

The words 'mine', 'yours', 'his', 'hers', 'its', 'ours', 'yours' and 'theirs' are known as possessive pronouns. Possessive pronouns stand alone and replace nouns to show possession.

**E.g.** This car is <u>mine</u>. (Possessive Pronoun)

(**सूचना:** विद्यार्थ्यांना Possessive Determiners आणि Possessive Pronouns यांमधील फरक माहीत असणे आवश्यक आहे. मालकी दर्शवण्यासाठी नामापूर्वी Possessive Determiners चा वापर केला जातो.

उदा. This is my car. (Possessive Determiner)

'mine', 'yours', 'his', 'hers', 'its', 'ours', 'yours' आणि 'theirs' हे possessive pronouns म्हणून ओळखले जातात. Possessive pronouns स्वतंत्रपणे येतात आणि स्वतःची मालकी दाखवण्याकरिता नामांची जागा घेतात. उदा. This car is mine (Possessive Pronoun)



### 4. Quantifiers

The words which are placed before nouns to indicate their **amount** or **quantity** are known as **quantifiers**. (Noun च्या आधी येणाऱ्या आणि Noun चे प्रमाण दर्शवणाऱ्या शब्दांना **quantifiers** असे म्हणतात.)

They are classified as follows:

### 5. Numerals

When numerals appear before nouns in order to **quantify** them they are known as **numeral determiners.** (Noun च्या आधी आलेला आणि न्दल्ह चे प्रमाण दर्शवणारा शब्द जर संख्या असेल, तर त्याला **numeral determiners** असे म्हणतात.)

There are two types: **cardinals** (one, two, three etc.) and **ordinals** (first, second, third etc.)

**e.g.** ♦ I have <u>one</u> dog.

I am <u>first</u> in line.

### **Order of Determiners**

More than one determiner can be used to modify a noun. In such cases there is an order in which determiners must be placed generally. The order can be remembered by using the mnemonic 'QUADPN'. (Noun बद्दल माहिती सांगण्यासाठी एकाहन अधिक determiners चा वापर केला जातो. अशावेळी 'QUADPN' या क्रमानसार determiners लावले जातात.)

**QU**: Quantifiers, **A**: Articles, **D**: Demonstratives, **P**: Possessives, **N**: Numerals **e.g.**

### **Things to Remember:**

- ✓ Articles specify nouns.
- ✓ Quatifiers come before nouns and indicate their amount or quantity.
- ✓ Numerals come before nouns in order to quantify them.

# **Synonyms and Antonyms**

**Synonyms:** A synonym is a word that has the same or nearly the same meaning as another word in the same language. For example, 'big' and 'large' are synonyms.

**Antonyms:** An antonym is a word opposite in meaning to another word in the same language. For example, 'fat' and 'thin' are antonyms. Antonyms may also be formed by the addition of prefixes or suffixes.

[Note: The synonym or antonym of any word must be in the same part of speech as the original word. For example, the synonyms 'ability' and 'skill' are both nouns and the antonyms 'fail' and 'succeed' are both verbs. (कोणत्याही शब्दाचा समानार्थी शब्द किंवा विरुद्धार्थी शब्द हा नेहमी मूळ शब्दाच्याच जातीमधील असायला हवा. उदाहरण: 'ability' आणि 'skill' हे दोन्ही समानार्थी शब्द नामे आहेत; 'fail' आणि 'succeed' हे दोन्ही विरुद्धार्थी शब्द क्रियापदे आहेत.]



### Things to Remember:

- Not all antonyms are created by adding prefixes and suffixes to words. e.g. friend x enemy (not 'un' friend)
- Synonyms and antonyms should be provided using single words alone, not meanings or word groups.
